As a US Navy SEAL sniper/medic I have studied, and tested ballistics of various rounds to include penetration through various mediums. I have not seen anything like Tru Armors laminate before. The first time I saw it I thought it was smoke and mirrors. Dave Trudeau shot two rounds through the glass from the inside striking a target that was on the other side. Then he turned the glass around and invited me to shoot the glass my self with my own weapon. I shot the glass with a 9mm multiple times. I went to inspect the glass and no penetration. So I went back to the firing line shot the glass with .45 acp. I figured that the glass would of failed by this point. But to my surprise there was virtually no damage to the back side of the laminate. We fired various different guns and caliber to include a M4. When I wen back up to the glass the most amount of damage to the Inside of the glass was a bulge. The front of the glass was riddled with rounds when Dave handed me a bat and said go ahead break the window. I hit at least ten times and the Glass did not fail. I am very impressed to say the least.
